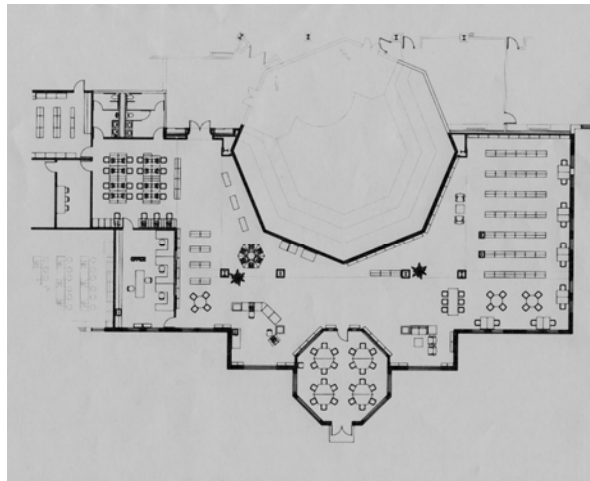


Scope:

Area: 8,050 sf

Completion: March 2001

Cost: \$11.6 million



As a part of a 52,000 sq. ft. major addition and renovation to the high school a new 8,050-sq. ft. Media Center was developed. Intended to provide library services to the high school as well as to the community, the plan allows direct access from the exterior. The Media Center is home to the schools collection of books, as well as a new computer/technology center including a television studio.

This project was an addition and renovation of the existing high school, which began construction in the spring of 2000. The additions included industrial science work shop areas, new bar structure, a new media center, as well as a fully functioning greenhouse for agricultural studies. The scope of renovation consisted of upgrading the science rooms, technical education rooms, music, and art areas.
